Policy Actions.

CWS – Wildland Urban Interface Cooperative Agreement.

He talked about these items at the Work Meeting. He did ask if the Council wanted to vote on the CWS. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to approve CWS State approved map. Council Member Davis seconded the motion. Mayor Jenkins asked for a roll call vote all in favor motion carried. The Council will need to adopt the 2024 WUI code and agree to sign the agreement. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to adopt 2024 WUI codes, attach the map, and sign the agreement. Council Member Davis seconded the motion. Mayor Jenkins called for a roll call vote all in favor motion carried.

UPDES Permit Actions.

Booster Pump Proposal.

There was no action needed on the UPDES. Mayor Jenkins said we need to accept the proposal for the booster pumps. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to move forward with the design of the booster pumps. Council Member Atherley seconded the motion. Mayor Jenkins called for roll call vote all in favor motion carried.

Dillon Higgs Waterline action.

Mayor Jenkins gave the background on what happened at their property. The water connection was never put back after the water project was completed. He will have Tyler figure out where the meter should go and put it back in.

Cory Wall, Discuss Purchase of City Property adjacent to his property.

Cory would like to purchase the property located behind his property on Railroad St. He said he believes that Boyce had also approached the city to purchase a section of the property. Council Member Atherley wanted to see a plat map of the property. Cory didn't bring it with him but explained that it was an old coal road. He would be willing to approach the other adjacent property owners about getting the property surveyed. They discussed the property and an updated survey and plat map are needed. The city may need to surplus the property.

Mammoth Water Association – Supplemental Water Lease Agreement.

Travis Haynes – Application for Building Permit for Garage.

The Planning Commission recommended approval of Travis's permit. Council Member Atherley made a motion to approve the building permit for Travis Haynes. Council Member Nedreberg seconded the motion. Mayor Jenkins called for a roll call vote all in favor motion carried. Travis will need to get the excavation permit submitted. Mayor Jenkins mentioned the city now has a new permit coordinator Tyler Elliott. Charles Davis said he wants to put in an impound yard and needs to put in a fence. He explained

the State requirements for the fence. Council Member Atherley said he would need to go before the Planning Commission.

### **CONSENT AGENDA**

Approval of Consent Agenda Items.

Minutes from March 9, 2026.

Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to approve the consent agenda item. Council Member Maxfield seconded the motion. Mayor Jenkins called for a roll call vote all in favor motion carried.

### **REPORT OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES**

Council Member Charles Davis – He asked if the Silver Jubilee required a Special Event Permit? Recorder Bigler said they have never got one in the past; however, they could check with the City Attorney. The Committee would like to bring the celebration back to Main St. He recommended a shuttle service that would run every 30 minutes. Recorder Bigler mentioned they would need to get permission from the property owners along Main St. The Committee needs to purchase banner brackets and banners for the light poles. He is requesting Council approval to withdraw \$3,000 out of the recreation fund to purchase them. Mayor Jenkins said it will need to be placed on the next meeting agenda. A quote for the items is also needed. Their meetings will be moved to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month.

Council Member Kimberly Clements - Absent

Council Member Thomas Nedreberg – He will have the Computech contract sent to Recorder Bigler.

Council Member Raeleen Maxfield – We received a full grant for the booster station. The Juab IS grant of \$2,000 for advertising the Silver Jubilee has been received. She will collaborate with the Recreation Committee on this project.

Council Member Tony Atherley – He had a meeting on the Gemini Sinkhole project. Dirt from the repository will be used to fill the sink hole.

Mayor Robert Jenkins – He is working with Council Member Maxfield to confirm the amount owed for the JUB project. The new city worker started today, and the other employee will start on April 6<sup>th</sup>.
