Dan brought up the design standards and proposal he sent back in February, asking if there were any questions or concerns. Mayor Dever asked him to go over it with Shay. Craig Bernetz from DEQ reached out to him regarding sinkholes and using the soil stockpiles the city has. Council Member Clements said she would check her emails to see if she received on from Craig. Council Member Haynes made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2025-09-22-02. Council Member Pugh seconded the motion. All in favor motion carried.

Resolution No. 2025-09-22-01 to Amend the Budget for FY Ending June 30, 2025. Council Member Clements made a motion to amend the budget for FY Ending June 30, 2025. Council Member Pugh seconded the motion. All in favor motion carried.

The property was recently donated to the city by family members of the person who owned it. Former Mayor Chris Dever had the properties that were donated surveyed by Ludlow Engineering. Council Member Haynes said he couldn't see the city keeping the piece of property in question and wanted to surplus it. Attorney Christopherson said it couldn't be done at tonight's meeting. A Public Hearing is required to surplus property. The property must be sold at fair market value. Because of the location of the property, he will research how to surplus and sell the property without a Public Hearing. The city will contact Andres with the findings and the price.

Nick Castleton and Paulette Carpeter, Property Exchange (Jarvis Street).

Council Member Pugh said the Planning Commission had recommended this to the Council for approval. A Public Hearing is required to vacate and swap the property. Attorney Christopherson would like to hold the Public Hearing the night of the next Council Meeting and also have it put on the agenda. He will get with Recorder Bigler to complete the necessary notices.
