Troy was born in Salt Lake City, Utah, to Vernon and Judy Jones, but was transported and raised in the beautiful, small town of Eureka, where Troy distinguished himself as a young boy who, "took the town by its horns" and involved or volunteered himself in school activities as well as outdoor adventures.

Troy was never one to 'sit back' and enjoy the ride, instead..,he was the 'Driver'. Troy attended Tintic High School, where he participated every year in the **Much Acclaimed** Tintic High School Concert and Marching Band, and played baseball, basketball, and track and Field. Troy was a superb athlete, and may even have played on a College basketball court if an injury to his knee hadn't occurred during a sleigh riding party. Troy Boy had the ability to do everything..,except avoid hitting his head or breaking a bone. He also wasn't able to dodge a ricocheting 22 bullet, which implanted itself in his leg, and stayed as a "good" souvenir and a bragging point.

Troy graduated from Tintic high School in 1981, attended Utah Technical College, and a year later married, Sharel

Copley. Together they lived in Eureka and raised three beautiful and talented girls; Amber, Kayla and Sammi.

Troy was an active member of the community and was always volunteering his time, especially when it came to coaching his 'girls'. Troy served as a Tintic District Board Member and he coached and mentored the High School Girl's basketball team. Troy was a lifelong member of the Tintic Elks Lodge BPOE, #711, where he rarely if ever, missed a Friday meeting.

Troy was a fighter, and never gave up! He valiantly fought Parkinson's Disease, in which he had been diagnosed in his mid-30's, and he would never let the disease define him, nor allow it to take away his ambitions in life. He continued to hunt, camp, fish, coach, and work as long as he was able to move...,he wasn't going to give in! He cherished his three girls, and adored his grandchildren. He managed to never miss a ballgame, a recital, birthday party, or any celebration that was a part of life!

Troy was a pillar to this community and will always remain a hero to many. Troy unexpectedly passed away, on May 6, 2017, prior to being able to receive the honor of being this year's, Grand Marshall. Just a week prior to leaving us, Troy had asked his sister, Amy, "...when are you going to write up that article about me?" Troy was honored to be held in such high regard to a community that he loved and honored.
