#### OPENING ON PLANNING COMMISSION

Eureka City Corporation is now accepting applications for one seat on the Planning Commission and two Alternate Members.

#### Powers and Duties.

The planning commission shall have such powers as may be necessary to enable it to perform its functions and promote municipal planning within the city. It shall:

1. Prepare and recommend a general plan and amendments to the general plan to the city council as provided under the provisions of Section 10-9a-302 et seq., UCA.

2. Prepare and recommend the adoption of zoning ordinances and a zoning map and any amendment to said zoning ordinances and map to the city council, as provided under the provisions of Section 10-9a-302 et seq., UCA.

3. Administer provisions of the zoning ordinance, where specifically provided for in the zoning ordinance adopted by the city council.

4. Prepare and recommend adoption of subdivision regulations and amendments to those regulations to the city council, as provided under the provisions of Section 10-9a-602 et seq., UCA.

5. Recommend approval or denial of subdivision applications as provided under the provisions of Section 10-9a-604 et seq., UCA, in accordance with the rules and procedures set forth under the terms of the subdivision ordinance.

6. Prepare and recommend adoption of regulations by the city governing the approval, construction and maintenance of condominium projects, or amendments to such regulations (UCA 57-8-35).

7. Advise the city council on such matters as the city council directs.

8. Hear and decide any matters designated to it by the city council under the terms of the city's zoning ordinance or other development regulation, including the approval or denial of, or recommendations to approve or deny, development site plans and conditional use permits, and other permits as designated by the Council.

9. Exercise any other powers: (a) that are necessary to enable it to perform its function; or (b) delegated to it by the city council.

All Applicants are required to submit a Resume along with their application. Applications will be accepted at the City Office, 15 North Church Street, Eureka, UT. Applications are available at the City Office or you may visit our website eurekautah.org.

#### **OPENING ON BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT**

Eureka City is seeking volunteers from our community to sit on an Appeal Authority Board or Board of Adjustment. We have three positions currently open and are in need of an alternate as well.

Definition of an Appeal Authority is: A person, board, authority, commission, agency or other body designated by ordinance to decide an appeal of a decision of a land use application or variance.

An Appeal Authority is empowered to hear and decide:

- 1. Appeals from zoning decisions applying the land use ordinance.
- 2. Variances from the provisions of the land use ordinance.

#### PART-TIME JOB OPENING

Eureka City is now accepting applications for 1 parttime employee to serve as the Landfill Attendant at the City's disposal facility. 4 hours per week (Saturdays), No Benefits.

Duties of the Landfill Attendant include: Monitors incoming vehicles transporting waste to four designated sites, records name, site being utilized, collects required fees from residents using the facility and writes receipts, inspects vehicles entering refuse site for possible hazardous materials that are not authorized to be disposed of at the Eureka refuse site, conducts inspection of sites and maintains them in a neat and orderly manner as much as possible, insures that no one under the age of 16 is allowed in the refuse site unless accompanied and supervised by their parent or legal guardian, insures that no one enters the roll-off bins, operates and records users of the Used Oil Collection Site according to State Regulations.

## **Chicken Parmigiana**

### Ingredients

- 1 egg, beaten
- 2 ounces dry bread crumbs
- 2 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves
- <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> (16 ounce) jar spaghetti sauce
- 2 ounces shredded mozzarella cheese
- 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese



## Directions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease a medium baking sheet.
- 2. Pour egg into a small shallow bowl. Place bread crumbs in a separate shallow bowl. Dip chicken into egg, then into bread crumbs. Place coated chicken on the prepared baking sheet.
- 3. Bake in the preheated oven until no longer pink and juices run clear, about 40 minutes. Remove from the oven.
- 4. Pour 1/2 of the spaghetti sauce into a 7x11-inch baking dish. Place chicken breasts over the sauce, then cover with remaining sauce. Sprinkle mozzarella and Parmesan cheeses on top. Continue baking until heated through and cheeses have melted, about 20 more minutes.
