CIVILIAN CONSERVATION CORPS

The Civilian Conservation Corps was established by the government after the Depression to help alleviate some of the effects from the Depression. It was originally called Emergency Conservation Work (ECW) and was designed to help solve two of the countries major problems of providing financial relief and implementing conservation projects. In Utah there were 116 camps in 27 of the 29 counties at one time or another over the nine year life of the CCC. The camps were overseen by government agencies such as the Forest Service and the Division of Grazing now known as the Bureau of Land Management. The camp closest to Eureka was the Jericho camp and was Company 288. One of our well known past residents, Joseph A. Bernini (now deceased) served in that Company.

I hope everyone will give them a big THANK YOU for spending Christmas Eve plowing snow so families could get where they needed to go without getting stuck. They both worked all night plowing and sanding the roads. I've had a chance to visit several other communities, large and small, in the central Utah area, and most of their roads are still not cleared of snow. Most of them never see a snow plow in their neighborhoods, so if you don't live on a through street, you are on your own after a snow storm. A simple thank you at least lets them know that their efforts are noticed and appreciated.

On the subject of snow, we're doing better about keeping vehicles off the roadways so the plows can get through, thank you. We are seeing a problem with those of us who are using 4 wheelers or snow blowers to clear our walks and driveways. If you push snow across the street or blow snow into the street, it is your responsibility to take a few more minutes and clean the snow back off the street. While you may think of the street in front of your house as yours, it still belongs to all the residents of town, so you owe it to everyone else in the community to keep it clear of snow, vehicles or any other obstacle.

The Residential Garbage Pass or Dump Card has been included with December's billing statement and newsletter, so please watch carefully when opening the bill and do not throw it away.

We have had issues in the past with residents throwing them away because they said they did not realize they were in with the bill. We are very careful when inserting them in the bills to make sure everyone gets their card. Everyone that currently pays for garbage pickup will receive a dump card with 6 dumps on the card. THE PERMIT MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE ATTENDANT at the dump area.

This will allow 6 free trips to the Roll-Off Bins. A \$15.00 fee per truckload and/or trailer load will be charged for additional trips.
