ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE IN TOWN

Eureka has seen an increase in the number of dogs running loose in town. There has been one pet killed on their own property and instances of dog attacks on residents. Please be advised that, as a dog owner, you have a responsibility to keep your dog "enclosed" on your property.

Eureka City Ordinance No. 980 says, in part:

13-242 A: It is unlawful for any person to keep, harbor or maintain any dog 6 months or more old unless such dog has been registered.

13-242 G: Anyone owning, keeping, harboring, or maintaining three or more dogs over the age of six months shall be considered operating a dog kennel and shall be required to pay an annual kennel license fee of \$25.00 per year.

13-244 RUNNING AT LARGE PROHIBITED:

A: It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog to permit such dog to run at large.

B: It shall be unlawful for any owner of a dog to permit such dog to go upon or be upon the private property of any person without the permission of the owner or person entitled to the possession of such private property.

C: The owner of any dog running at large shall be deemed in violation of this section regardless of the precautions taken to prevent the escape of the dog and prohibit it from running at large.

13-247 Every owner of any dog over the age of six months within the municipality shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a duly licensed veterinarian.

13-249 DOGS WHICH DISTURB NEIGHBORHOOD

No person shall own, keep or harbor any dog which by loud, continued, or frequent barking, howling, yelping or by noxious or offensive odors shall annoy, disturb or endanger the health and welfare of any person or neighborhood.

13-272 ANIMAL CONTROL BAIL/FINE SCHECULE

C: Public Nuisance (i.e. barking, chasing people, vehicles odor etc.) \$25.00 first offense, \$35.00 second offense, \$75.00 third offense.

D: Attacks by dogs & cats on persons: \$125.00, attacks on animals: \$30.00.

E: Possession of a vicious dog: \$100.00
