PUBLIC NOTICE of COMPLETION Five-Year Review for the Eureka Mills Superfund Site Juab County, Utah



Summary: Fourth Five-Year Review Completed

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Environmental Response and Remediation (UDEQ/DERR), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 8, have completed the fourth Five-Year Review for the Eureka Mills Superfund Site. Five-Year Reviews are required by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) when hazardous substances remain on site above levels that permit unrestricted use and unlimited exposure. Five-Year Reviews are conducted to evaluate the site remedy and to determine whether site conditions remain protective of human health and the environment.

Protectiveness Statement: The EPA has determined in the Five-Year Review that the cleanup remedies in place at Operable Units 00-04 at the Eureka Mills Superfund Site are protective of human health and the environment. Exposure to mine wastes were addressed through remedial and removal actions to grade and cap the mine wastes in place with geotextile liners and armored rock and excavation of contaminated soils in residential and commercial properties. Implementation of environmental covenants, a local land use ordinance, and the Soil Excavation Permit Program continue to address excavation work in Eureka where contaminated soils are left in place.

This Five-Year Review Report was signed July 18, 2023 and the next Five-Year Review is required five years from the completion date. A copy of the review is available at the DERR Offices located on the 1st Floor, at 195 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84114.
