ELECTION NEWS

Eureka City Municipal Primary Election was held August 12, 2025. The results from that election were recently Canvassed and Certified by the City Recorder/Election Officer and the Eureka City Mayor and City Council in a regular meeting held on August 25, 2025. The results of that were:

Shane Emery Charlesworth	5
Robert W. Jenkins	54
Scott C. Pugh	88

Therefore, Robert W. Jenkins and Scott C. Pugh will be moving forward to the General Election, to be held November 4, 2025.

Originally, Eureka City did not receive any Declaration of Candidacy forms for the two City Council positions that were up for election.

The Write-in Candidate Deadline was August 29, 2025 at 5:00 pm. Eureka City received three Write-in Candidate Declaration of Candidacy Forms for City Council Member (4-Year Term) prior to that deadline. Those filing a Write-In Declaration of Candidacy Form were:

Tony Steven Atherley
Jonathan G. Street
Raeleen Anita Maxfield

Although they filed for the Council Member seats, their names will not be on the ballot for the November election. Instead, there will be two blank lines on the ballot under Council Member and the voters will need to ***“Write-In”*** the names of two candidates they wish to vote for.

BUSINESS LICENSES

Eureka City Business Licenses can now be obtained through our website: www.eureka.utah.gov. For those businesses that already have a license, you can even renew your license online through this process as well.

Below is a step by step process:

- ◆ Go to our website, www.eureka.utah.gov.
- ◆ Click on the Business Tab at the top of the page. (Please read all pertinent information in our City Code pertaining to Business Licenses.)
- ◆ Click on the Business License Application link that is provided and it will take you to the Citizen Portal.
- ◆ From there, choose whether it is an existing business or a new business.
- ◆ Fill out ALL required information.
- ◆ Upload any pertinent Documents (if needed)
 - State Registration
 - Sales Tax License
 - Health Department

License approval still has to go through Planning & Zoning for a recommendation and then the Eureka City Council for approval.

Once approved, there is a payment option in the Citizen Portal to pay online through Payroc.
