DISCUSSION ITEMS

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor.
Shay was unable to attend the meeting.

Dan Fechner, City Engineer – Presentation of Bids on Booster Station Reconstruction.
Dan read the bids from C&E General Construction \$154,000, Whitaker Construction \$164,350, JLR Contractors \$175,680, Condi Construction \$183,140, Van Con Construction \$185,500, Taurus Plumbing & Excavation \$187,550. After discussing the bids, Jones & DeMille recommended going with Whitaker Construction. The grant the city received will not cover all the cost because of the addendum that was added to replace the booster motor that just went out. The average price for the motor was \$20,000 - \$30,000. The city will have to fund the overage. Mayor Jenkins had discussed potential booster failure with fire personnel and the State during the fire. We may be able to have them pay for the booster since it failed just after the fire.

WUI Ordinance & Map.

Mayor Jenkins said it is still in progress. He has been working with Fire Chief Lynn Elliott to get the map completed. The State has been contacted and now we are currently working on it.

Recreation Committee:

Update on the progress of Tintic Silver Jubilee.

Council Member Maxfield stated the bands and inflatables are booked. She doesn't have a number on the entries on the car show or vendors. They have spent a lot of time advertising. The parade is ready to go. They will be meeting tomorrow night.
