DISCUSSION ITEMS

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor.

He discussed the UDOT crosswalk project letting everyone know the study will take place in early May on a school day. During the study they will decide if the current location of the crosswalk at the elementary school should stay or be moved. If they keep the current location, they will consider adding lights and other safety measures to it. After the conclusion of the study the results will be made available to the city in 2 - 3 weeks. He sent out the updated WUI code. Most communities are adopting the map Breann sent out. He sent the wage policy to recorder Bigler today. It highlights the two certifications that Recorder Bigler sent over. He recommends the wages be added into the policy. Council Members Maxfield and Nedreberg have registered for the R6 regional training. The Project Portal CIB list is due May 1st. Mayor Jenkins said he is still trying to figure out what projects need to be put on the list.

Dan Fechner, City Engineer.

UPDES Permit Discussion.

Review of the Booster Pump Design.

Council Member Maxfield feels we should stay with our current UPDES permit. Dan said the booster pump design proposal fees align with what we applied for and should be included in the grant amount. He said the timeline should be 6 - 8 weeks for the design then it goes out to bid. Bids are usually advertised for 2 – 3 weeks. Looking at mid-summer before the project gets started. Some discussion took place on the backup water supply by using the Vulcan well and the possibility of water restrictions while getting the problem fixed. Dan met with the Planning Commission to discuss the updated design standards for streets. He gave a rundown of what took place at that meeting.

Charles Davis, Culvert extension.

Mayor Jenkins explained why a culvert extension was needed. Council Member Atherley said there needs to be a survey, a permit, and a plan in place. He gave a more in depth explanation of what was needed. The starting point for this process will be attending a Planning Commission meeting.
